RIDE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

The safety of our guests and associates is our number one priority at California's Great America. Safety is a shared partnership between the park and our guests. Height requirements and any special instructions regarding the ride are posted at the entrance of every ride. Guests are asked to follow all posted and verbal instructions and carefully consider the ride requirements and use good judgment before, during and after their ride.

Great America has the right to make the final decision regarding eligibility of a rider based on a person's size, weight or other physical or mental limitations; provided the guest has properly disclosed any physical or mental impairment(s).

While riding, you must remain seated facing forward in an upright position with your back and shoulders against the seat back and hold on until the ride comes to a complete stop. All passenger restraint systems, including lap bars, shoulder harnesses and seatbelts must be positioned properly and fastened tightly.

Any guest who would like more information on any ride is encouraged to visit Guest Services or Town Hall to obtain a Guest Assistance Guide.

LOOSE ARTICLES We recommend you leave all personal belongings in a locker, with a non-rider or locked in the trunk of your vehicle. **FOR YOUR SAFETY, DO NOT ENTER UNAUTHORIZED AREAS TO RETRIEVE LOST ARTICLES.**

Due to the nature of rides, items that do not fit in a cargo pocket or waist pack that securely closes will not be permitted. Waist packs must be able to be lifted over a tightened seatbelt or lap bar and may not interfere with the proper function of the restraint system or proper riding position with back and shoulders against the seat back. Your hands must be free to hold on while riding, therefore nothing can be held in your hands. All food and drink must be finished prior to boarding any ride or entering any ride station. If you lose an item, notify a ride operator for assistance. For your safety, do not enter fenced areas. Entering a fenced area may result in serious injury.

Any guest who intentionally disables a safety restraint, breaks a ride admission policy or whose actions endanger themselves or others will be required to leave the park.

Based on rider height, some rides may require a guest to be accompanied by a **SUPERVISING COMPANION** to ride. A supervising companion is someone who meets all the requirements to ride the ride themselves, is 14 years of age or older, and demonstrates appropriate observed behavior. Supervising companions are responsible for ensuring that the guest remains seated properly in the same seat (row) as the guest who needs accompaniment and can accompany the number of riders for which the seat is designed. For example, if a seat is designed for three people, the supervising companion can accompany two riders.

HAND-HELD INFANTS/SMALL CHILDREN are not permitted on most rides. A hand-held infant is a child who is unable to walk to the ride unit independently or maintain independent seated postural control during the ride.

GUEST INFORMATION



The **DRESS CODE** requires all guests to wear tops and pants/shorts that must fit correctly at the waist line and shoes at all times while in the park. Clothing that disguises or alters a person's identity and clothing or exposed tattoos with profanity, illegal substances or other suggestive/offensive material are prohibited. California's Great America has the sole discretion to determine what is appropriate and reserves the right to refuse admission to any guest or ask anyone who is not in compliance with these rules to leave the park.



ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES may not be brought into the park. Guests must be at least 21 years of age and have a valid government issued identification with photo or valid driver's license to purchase, possess or consume alcoholic beverages. California's Great America reserves the right to refuse service and to limit the amount of alcohol served. Alcohol service stops 1 hour prior to park closing.



ANIMALS other than guide/service animals are prohibited. Refer to the park map for the location of the Service Animal Relief Station.



If your **BEHAVIOR** is not what is deemed appropriate for a family amusement park, or you refuse to follow established policies or procedures, you will be required to leave park property. In this event, no refunds will be issued.



The use of **CAMERA** phones, video recording devices or still photography cameras is prohibited in all restrooms and on all rides.



If you need **FIRST AID** attention, please visit our facility located near Town Hall. If you require immediate attention, notify a California's Great America associate.



FAMILY CARE CENTER located in Planet Snoopy, is an area for parents to change diapers, feed a baby in a private room or just relax with small children in air conditioned comfort.



GUEST WITH DISABILITIES should visit Guest Services or Town Hall for information regarding park and ride accessibility.



LINE JUMPING, regardless of the reason, is prohibited. Line jumping includes cutting in front of other guests already waiting in line and leaving a line and then attempting to re-enter at the same point. Saving a place for another guest is prohibited. Line jumpers will be required to leave the park. No refund will be issued.



LOST CHILDREN are taken to the Family Care Center. If your child is lost, please contact any California's Great America associate for assistance. Sorry, we cannot page lost or separated families.



LOST & FOUND is located at Guest Services. Items will be retrieved from ride areas when the park is closed and kept for a limited time. California's Great America is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items. **FOR YOUR SAFETY, DO NOT ENTER RESTRICTED AREAS TO RETRIEVE LOST ARTICLES.** You may be seriously injured if you enter an unauthorized area. Unclaimed lost articles are donated to charity or destroyed after 14 days.



KIDTRACK is a free program that assists in quickly reuniting lost children with their parents. Guests with cell phones can register for this safety system at Guest Services, Town Hall or Family Care Center.



PARENT SWAP is a program intended to help parents with small children. To participate, one parent waits in line and both get to ride (separately). To participate in Parent Swap, parents need to obtain a slip at Guest Services or Town Hall.



PERSONAL BELONGINGS such as non-essential purses, back packs, waist packs and other bags should be left at home or locked in the trunk of your vehicle. Outside food and/or beverages, coolers, glass containers, sharp objects (including pocket knives and metal chains), firearms or other items that could be considered a weapon are strictly prohibited. All items brought into the park are subject to inspection by California's Great America Security. California's Great America is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged articles.



A Season Pass or **RE-ENTRY** ticket, available at designated exit turnstiles, is required when returning on the same day. One parking lot re-entry is permitted by showing your parking ticket at the tollbooths.



RENTAL lockers, strollers, wheelchairs and electric scooters are available inside the park entrance.



For your safety, **RIDE AVAILABILITY** may be limited due to required maintenance or other causes.



SMOKING of any kind, including vapor and e-cigarettes, is not permitted inside California's Great America. For the comfort of all guests, smoking is only permitted in the designated smoking area just outside the park entrance gate.



Some rides and attractions may close in bad **WEATHER** until conditions permit safe operations. Please enjoy a show, meal or shopping until such weather passes. California's Great America cannot issue rain checks or refunds for inclement weather.

WARNING

Many rides at California's Great America are dynamic and thrilling. There are inherent risks in riding any amusement ride. For your protection, each ride is rated for its special features, such as high speed, steep drops, sharp turns or other dynamic forces. If you choose to ride, you accept all of these risks. Restrictions for guests of larger size (height or weight) are posted at certain rides. Guests with disabilities should refer to our Guest Assistance Guide available at Guest Services. Participate responsibly. You should be in good health to ride safely. You know your physical conditions and limitations. If you suspect your health could be at risk for any reason, or if you could aggravate a pre-existing condition of any kind, **DO NOT RIDE!**

Prices, policies, and attraction availability are subject to change without notice. California's Great America reserves the right to be closed to the public for any reason. No refunds or rain checks. Food & beverages may not be brought inside the park.

BAG POLICY

To increase safety and provide efficient entry into the park during Tricks and Treats, guests will be asked to adhere to a new policy which states that no bags of any kind larger than 6.5" x 4.5" x 2" may be brought into the park after 6 p.m. on Tricks and Treats nights. All bags will be subject to search.




TRICKS & TREATS COSTUME POLICY

Halloween is for EVERYONE, which is why ALL Guests are welcome to wear costumes and face paint during the Tricks and Treats event.

Costume guidelines for ALL AGES:

- Attire and accessories must meet Code of Conduct.
- Costumes, masks, props, and accessories that conceal identity are prohibited.
- Costumes must be family friendly and may not be obstructive, offensive, objectionable, obscene, or violent.
- Layered costumes or costume props that surround the entire body are strongly discouraged and may be subject to additional security screening.
- Clothing which, by nature, exposes excessive portions of the skin that may be viewed as inappropriate for a family environment are not allowed.
- Costumes may not contain any props or accessories that resemble or could easily be mistaken for an actual weapon.
- No sharp or pointed objects or materials that could accidentally strike other guests.
- Guests wearing character themed outfits may not sign autographs for other guests or represent themselves as a park associate.
- For safety reasons, rides and attractions may also have additional restrictions on dress attire.
- Costume guidelines for Guests 12 years of age and younger:
- Costume masks may be worn and must always provide unobstructed peripheral vision with openings that allow the eyes to be fully seen.
